Wednesday, June 26th

8:30 am—2:30 pm, Gettysburg Battlefield Tour & Lunch— The air-conditioned bus will leave from in front of the hotel at 8:30 am sharp. It will take you to the National Military Park, Museum and Visitors Center for your orientation. There you will see a 20 minute film narrated by Morgan Freeman, film, the 42 foot high Cyclorama, followed by a tour of the museum. From there you proceed to General Pickett's Buffet, which is right on the edge of the battlefield for a hot buffet lunch. After lunch your two hour narrated tour of the battlefield with a licensed guide begins. The guide will bring you back to the hotel by 2:30 pm. All expenses and fees are included.

Late afternoon—evening We have scheduled two opportunities for you and your family to enjoy the rest of the day.

5:00 pm—9:00 pm—An evening in historic Gettysburg for dinner, shops and museums. Get there by car or by taking the Freedom Shuttle which leaves from the hotel every hour on the half hour for \$1 each way.

5:30 pm—9:00 pm— Guided Rallye through the historic country side with covered bridges, a stop for dinner, ending in Gettysburg Town Square. Leaving the hotel from the ROA reserved parking.

Thursday, June 27th,

8:00 am—2:00 pm, AACA Museum & Hershey Chocolate World— The air-conditioned bus will leave from in front of the hotel at 8:00 am sharp. After about an hour's drive you arrive at the famous Antique Automobile Club of America's (AACA) Museum in Hershey. Although we had the opportunity to visit this outstanding museum during our meet in 2010 the displays are renewed about every six months.

After the tour of the museum the bus will stop at Chocolate World in Hershey Park for a tour and lunch on your own in one of their many restaurants. After lunch the bus will return to the hotel at 2:00 pm. That will give you time to relax, freshen up and attend the Technical Advisors Q&A at 3:30 pm. That evening we hold our annual meeting, followed by door prizes hot d' oeuvres and information on setting up for the show on Friday.
