

WHAT TO DO IN KALAMAZOO!

GILMORE CAR MUSEUM

6865 W. HICKORY ROAD, HICKORY CORNERS, MI

This eye-popping auto museum is the largest in America, with 400 vehicles displayed in numerous structures — a total of 190,000 sq. ft. — on a 90-acre campus. The Gilmore includes an original reconstructed 1941 Diner and a 1930 Shell gas station. Rated one of the top three auto museums in the nation, Hemmings calls it the "World's Greatest Car Collection."



Best of all, the museum is located an easy 15 country miles from the hotel and is open Monday through Friday, 9 am to 5 pm. Admission is \$15 for adults or get a two-day pass for \$25. For more information, visit www.gilmorecarmuseum.org.



AIR ZOO AEROSPACE & SCIENCE EXPERIENCE

A world-class, Smithsonian-affiliated aerospace and science museum, the Air Zoo is located just three miles from our host hotel. More than 100 rare and unique
