

# Rise and Dine at Ruby's! (then let's walk it off at the *Automobile Driving Museum*) Sunday, January 18<sup>th</sup> in Anaheim, CA then driving out to El Segundo, CA

It's a new year, and we should get some exercise. Our Rivas and Toronados could use some exercise too! For those of you who haven't heard of the Automobile Driving Museum (ADM), it is a very unique automobile museum. Unlike most museums that rope everything off, at ADM, they encourage visitors to fully experience their 130 cars. That includes (on Sundays only) taking visitors for rides in some of their vehicles. On Sunday, January 18<sup>th</sup>, the cars scheduled for visitor rides are a '32 Packard coupe, a '38 Buick sedan, and a '64 Malibu SS (all subject to change, of course).



For those of you who live east or south of El Segundo (or who just like eating, lol) and would like to meet first for breakfast, let's plan to meet no later than **8:30 AM** for breakfast at Ruby's Diner in Anaheim (we've met there before... they have a great parking lot for us to all park together). It's located at 1128 W. Lincoln Avenue, Anaheim (immediately east of the 5 Freeway at the Lincoln Exit). We'll have breakfast there and then fire up the cars at a bit before 10 for the 32 mile caravan to El Segundo. The Museum opens at 10AM; the last ride is at 3:30. Plan to stay as long as you wish. Admission is \$10, \$8 for seniors 62+, \$5 for kids.

For those of you who live north and west of El Segundo, you might not want to also drive to Anaheim for breakfast. If so, instead, you can meet us at the Museum directly if you wish.
